"Life in the Suburbs" is the theme of a color photo contest sponsored by the Observer & Eccentric Newspapers. Amateur photographers are invited to enter. Winning pictures will be featured in this newspaper.

All photographs should be submitted in slide form. Pictures must be taken in one of the following 12 suburbs served by the Observer & Eccentric Newspapers. They are Livonia, Westland, Garden City, Redford Township, Plymouth, and Canton Township in Wayne County. In Oakland County the communities are Birmingham, West Bloomfield, Troy, Rochester, Southfield and Farmington Hills.

Winners will receive gift certificates from World Camera and Sound. First prize will be a \$100 certificate, second prize, \$75, and third prize, \$40.

Three gift certificates of \$10 each will be presented for honorable mention. The certificates will be redeemable in World Camera stores in Birmingham, Avon Township and Livonia.

Here are the rules: All color photographs in slide form should have been taken within the last year (from July 1977 through July 1978) in one of the 12 communities listed. Note the location on the entry.

The contest is open to amateur photographers, which is defined as those who are not employed in photography work or making a living through photography. There is no age limit.

Each contestant may submit two slides. They can be of two different subjects. Each slide should be clearly marked with the contestant's name and community.

Deadline for receipt of entries is July 31.

Observer & Eccentric Newspapers are not responsible for the return of slides or damage to them. After the contest, entries may be picked up at the Livonia office, 36251 Schoolcraft.

Photos will be judged by a panel of editors and photographers. Criteria for judging will include composition, originality, how well the subject typifies suburban lifestyle, and how well the slide will reproduce as a color newspaper picture. It should be noted that bright colors usually look better in a color print for newspapers.

## Big ifs apply in refreezing

You can refreeze meat if it has been thawed in the refrigerator, if it is still fresh and good—and if it is still cold an still has some ice crystals left. You do need to recognize though that each time a cut of meat is frozen and thawed, you lose some of the goodness

you paid for to begin with. There's a drying tendency, due to loss of juices, in the process of thawing and refreezing. The better method though is to keep the thawed meat in the refrigerator and cook it as soon as possible.
