Make plans early if you intend to attend fireworks

If you're heading downtown for the fireworks display at 9:55 p.m. Friday, Detroit police suggest taking Michigan, Grand River, Gratiot or Woodward avenues.

Police will close some surface streets and freeways to regulate traffic. More than 500,000 are expected to flock downtown.

All freeway closings will begin at 6:45 p.m. The Chrysler Freeway will be closed from Madison to downtown. The Lodge will close initially at Bagley and progressively close back to I-94. Fisher Freeway traffic will not be permitted to exit onto the southbound Lodge or the north and southbound Chrysler beginning at 6:45 p.m. The Jeffries Freeway entrance to the Lodge (near Tiger Stadium) will be closed.

All downtown streets south of Fort Street and west of Woodward will be closed to vehicular traffic at 7:15 p.m. Westbound Larned and eastbound Congress will remain open throughout the evening. Jefferson Avenue will be closed from the Lodge to the Chrysler Freeway to both east and westbound traffic.

Street parking will be very limited and will not be permitted at all downtown. Public parking lots are the best bet for spectators.

Detroit's Department of Transportation (DOT), is providing special flyer service from five shopping centers on the city's perimeter. Coaches will begin departure at 5:30 p.m. from Eastland, Northland, Wonderland, Grandland (Grand River near Southfield), and the Montgomery Ward Center at Gratiot and Seven Mile Road.

Bus fares each way from Eastland, Northland, and Wonderland will be 75 cents and 50 cents from Grandland and the Montgomery Ward Center. For more information, call DOT, 224-3768. Return bus service will be available.

SEMTA will be offering special rail service to the fireworks. Train One will leave Pontiac at 7:30 p.m. and stop at Bloomfield, Birmingham, Royal Oak and Ferndale and arrive at the Renaissance Center at 8:30 p.m. Train Two will make the same stops a half hour later.

Return trains will leave the Renaissance Center 25 and 45 minutes after the fireworks. Round trip fare is \$3 for adults and \$1 for children under 12. Special tickets are required and will be available until trains are filled. Tickets are available at SEMTA's Royal Oak train station and at Huson's Oakland and Pontiac stores.

There are several free entertainment events for those who will arrive downtown early.

Cinema Canada features the film "Games of the XXI Olympiad" (1976 Montreal Olympics) at the Ford Auditorium at 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. Roving musicians will be all over downtown beginning at 6 p.m.

At 6:30 p.m. the Freedom and Ethnic Festival opening ceremonies will take place at the Hart Plaza. At 8 p.m. the new Chamber of Commerce musical, "My Detroit—Welcome To It," will be presented at the Michigan and Third Ethnic Festival site. At 9 p.m. the "Up With People" program will be presented at Hart Plaza.

The Renaissance Center will be sealed off to all vehicular traffic at 6 p.m. and pedestrian traffic in and around the Detroit Plaza Hotel. The office towers will be limited to persons with special passes. Plaza Hotel room keys will not be sufficient for entry to the area; the special pass must be presented. Passes only will also be the policy at the Hotel Pontchartrain and the City-County Building.

The Detroit police will staff a station for lost persons at the Veterans Memorial Building between Cobo Hall and the Renaissance Center.

The fireworks are sponsored by Hudson's and Stroll's Brewery.

Party secrets

Dress up your party table with easy-to-prepare curried almonds.

Spread two cups whole blanched almonds in shallow baking pan. Dot with one tablespoon butter. Bake in 350-degree oven about 20 minutes or until golden and toasty brown. When butter melts, stir or shake pan to coat nuts evenly. Remove from oven.

Blend two teaspoons seasoned salt and 3/4-teaspoon curry powder in a mortar with pestle. Sprinkle over nuts and return to oven.

Continue baking for several minutes for seasonings to bake in. Remove from oven and spread on absorbent paper to cool. Makes two cups.
