Greek festival to offer food, music, dancing

The Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Church in Farmington Hills will swing into high gear on July 14, 15 and 16 for the annual "Glendi" celebration.

The church grounds at 2525 Middlebelt will be transformed into a gay and colorful replica of the night life of Athens at that weekend.

Chairman of the steering committee for the Greek celebration will be Samuel Kapas of Southfield. He is immediate past president of the parish council and has been active in the building and sites program.

The infectious gaiety of the bouzouka music, with the nationally known Rhodian Orchestra, the sparkle of the Athenian way of life, the Taverna atmosphere of the Plaka and Piraeus districts will blend for a Greek holiday event.

There will be a variety of cooked Greek food, folk dancing and the famous Syrtaki sailor dance, souvlaki and the ever-popular loukumades (puffed Greek honey puffs).

The Aegean Sidewalk Cafe will offer Greek pastry and baked goods and coffee, all of which can be purchased and taken home.

The Taverna with its multiple choice of imported Greek wines and liqueurs together with the cheeses and mezedakia (hors d'oeuvres) of Greece, will add to the native Greek atmosphere.

Greek boutiques will feature imported jewelry, crafts and novelties. Imported Greek fashion and Mykonos sailor caps will be available. Dancers in native Greek costumes will entertain and invite the guests to join in the

Additional activities will be games, a Greek-thumb flower shop and handicrafts made during the year by women of the church.

The celebration officially begins at 5 p.m., July 14. Hours are noon to midnight Saturday and noon to 11 p.m. Sunday.
