

Morrow, Dorsey appearing on P'Jazz

Chuck Muer's P'Jazz at the Pontch, already attracting the largest crowds in its seven-year history, steps into high gear next week.

Buddy Morrow and the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra will appear on Monday and the Thad Jones/Mel Lewis Orchestra on Wednesday.

Both concerts will begin at 6 p.m. outdoors on the poolside terrace of the Hotel Pontchartrain in downtown Detroit. General admission tickets are

priced for each session and will be available after 5 p.m.

Buddy Morrow was formerly a featured player with the orchestra of Tommy Dorsey. Now as conductor, he insists that the band retain the authen-

tic sound and style of the late "Sentimental Gentleman of Swing."

Members of the group have an average age of 22 and most are graduates of fine music schools. They perform the best loved of Tommy Dorsey's 330 original arrangements including "Marie," "Song of India" and "Opus No. 1."

THE THAD JONES and Mel Lewis concert follows their recent White House performance and promises to

be a nostalgic visit to the Motor City. It was in Detroit in 1953 during a so-called "Battle of the Bands" that a drummer with Stan Kenton and a sideman with Count Basie met and formed the idea for a Thad Jones/Mel Lewis Orchestra.

The group's distinctive sound encompasses the music of today, tomorrow and yesterday. Worldwide tours have generated enthusiastic response.

Meadow Brook Hall filled with charm

Almost like a magic castle, the many-chimneyed Tudor Mansion Meadow Brook Hall waits half-hidden in the rolling hills of Rochester.

Its 100 rooms are filled with priceless treasures. Gardens and fountains, shade trees and winding walks invite visitors to explore the wooded grounds.

During July and August Meadow Brook Hall is open for tours 10 a.m.—5 p.m. every day but Sunday. On Sundays the hall is open 1—5 p.m.

Behind the massive entrance gates are crystal chandeliers and silk-covered walls, master paintings, tapestries woven hundreds of years ago, glass and china collectibles, gold fixtures and hand-carved paneling. Antique furnishings were shipped from around the world to decorate the home that cost more than three million dol-

lars to build in the late 1920s.

THE FORMER HOME of Matilda Dodge Wilson (she was the widow of auto pioneer John Dodge), the hall is now used as a cultural and conference center for Oakland University.

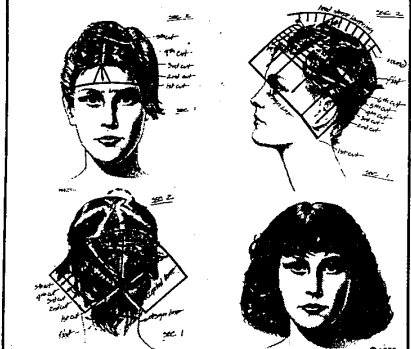

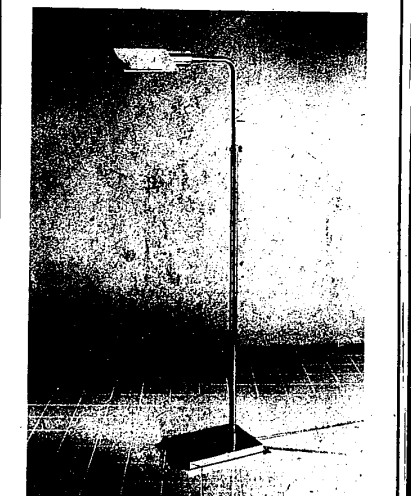
