One of the most interesting rivalries that has developed on the Detroit bowling front in years is now taking place in the spring mixed invitational classic.

It is a struggle between Mary Mohrasi, the reigning bowling queen and Penny Behn, a member of her court. It also is a struggle between a veteran of the lanes and one of the younger stars. This is the kind of a set-up that always makes things interesting.

According to the latest figures Mrs. Mohrasi is out in front with an average of 197 for 15 games, while her younger rival is listed at 186 in 18 games.

The invitational runs through the summer, traveling to a different establishment each week. Under the present conditions the average battle may go down to the last date.

A SPECIAL PROGRAM is being planned for the John Gavis Sweepstakes that always opens the bowling season during the last week in August.

Aside from the regular competition among the 16 bowling teams, the attention will be focused on the Goebel charity event that made possible the purchase of four leader dogs for the blind.

The money will be turned over with suitable ceremonies before the pins fall. And, in contrast to other years when the Gavis event was held in Allen Park it will be held at Sunnybrook Lanes.

These suburban lanes are located at Seventeen Mile Road and Van Dyke and every effort is being made to have the recipients of the dogs on hand for the festivities.

ROCKY GRAZIANI, long rated one of the top bowlers in the area, lived up to his reputation last week when he paced the field in the Strow Bonanza Open at North Hill Lanes.

To win the top place he averaged 233 and won 10 of his 12 matches. He built up a lead of more than 200 pins and coasted to victory in the final matches.

The victory was his second in the Michigan Majors championships.

PEPE OVERSTREET is finding the Westland Bowl Lanes to his liking.

Several weeks ago he fashioned a 745 in the men's Tuesday league and came back last week with a spurge that netted games of 267, 287 and 248 for a 723.

Interest in youth bowling also is being centered on the Westland lanes these days, all because of the performance of two young lads.

Don Wolfe, a boy of 11, scattered the pins for a 210 in a 571 series. Right him came Mark Footit, 12 years old, who strung games of 180, 190 and 174 for 544.

IN THE MEN'S TUESDAY loop at Garden Lanes, Richard Hall took over the spotlight with a 644 series. This was good enough to give him a 28-in lead over Vic Kelly.
