pations.

Future bartenders learn creme drinks first, then move to martinis and manhattans, pass on to fruit juice based drinks like Singapore Slings. The mixing men and women accelerate to poured liquors like

Seven & Sevens, promote to cordial and liquor mixes like Rusty Nails and on up in the luscious layered or cordial category like Angel Tips, the 29-year-old manager says.

CUSTOMER SERVICE from tip handling to handling a drunk properly is also taught in the 46 hour course. Bartenders are responsible for serving customers who are intoxicated, Hart explains, so a good hartender doesn't want to encourage drunks to keep drinking and also desen't want to insuit a good customer.

"We teach bartenders to put two cups of coffee on the bar, one for the bartender and one for the customer. We teach our students customer psychology," he adds.

"SEVENTY PERCENT of our stu-dents will pass the speed test on their first attempt," Hart explains. Bartending jobs are plentiful, the manager explains and the school employs a full-time placement direc-tor.

tor.
Graduates are entitled to return to
any of the 23 Professional Bar Tenders Schools in the country for a
brush-up course or to utilize their
placement services, he says.

"She makes 300 calls a week to see who's hiring," he adds. "She aver-ages about 80 job orders per week which is more than satisfactory for the number of graduates we have."

Hart says there are 15,000 estab-lishments in the Detroit metropolitan area that serve liquor, averaging three bartenders per establishment. That makes for 45,000 bartenders with an average tumover raile rate of every six months, so Hart esti-mates there are 90,000 jobs available annually.

Bartenders pay rate is between \$250-\$350 dollar a week, Hart says. Part-timers can make between \$100-\$150 for two evenings of work a week

week.

Bartenders are no longer prima-rily men. As a matter of fact, Hart reports many establishments are requesting women.

"The good hotels are looking for bartenders who are good, reliable and hones." The adds.

Deb Torres drives from Flint everyday to attend bartending school. She says the class is fun and she wants to get a job in one of the Flint Sheratons.

"There's no money in discos," says Ray Skowronek, 18, who would make rough for businessmen when he graduates.
