un Ortenaro Lasse Road won't be neceded with 1878. "This does nothing to change the status or timing of the Orchard Lake Road project." said Gnau. "Due to time required to complete the environmental analysis required to obtain federal aid for Orchard Lake, we simply can't get construction under way this year."

Gnau said all of the resurfacing projects are on county primary roads, for

which the road commission pays the full cost. The fact that cost sharing agreements, public hearings and complicated engineering, won't be necessary for the projects was a factor in selecting them for addition to the 1978 program. "If usual circumstances prevail, we should be able to get all the projects completed before this winter." he said.
