

Rice meets Ohio team

High school football predictions revealed

BROTHER RICE VERSUS BARBERTON (OHIO): In a uniquely ambitious game the number one ranked Warriors travel to Ohio, where they will square off with the top-ranked Ohio team. Although the powerful history of Ohio prep football dictates otherwise, look for Rice by three points.

BIRMINGHAM SEAHOLM VERSUS HAZEL PARK: Maple coach Chuck Skinner leads the Maples to the same field where he coached Hazel Park teams for 22 years. Seaholm has scored 90 points in two early season victories and should win handily for its coach's reunion.

BIRMINGHAM GROVES VERSUS ROYAL OAK DONDERO: The Falcons begin their Metro Suburban Activities Association title defense against the same team they deprived of that honor last season. This looks like Groves by eight points in a close-fought game.

'BLOOMFIELD HILLS ANDOVER VERSUS MILFORD: The Barons will win this game at Milford as a successful start to regaining the Greater Oakland Activities League crown which Andover lost last year after three consecutive championships.

FARMINGTON VS. LAKELAND: Little is known about faraway Milford Lakeland, but coach Hal Beardsley's Farmington High squad is much better than its 0-2 record indicates. Farmington should come away with its first win Saturday.

TROY AT EISENHOWER: Troy struggled to win offense against Berkley in overtime, then were shutout by Athens last week. Eisen-

hower is 2-0, beating Rochester Adams 27-2 Friday night. Troy's offense hasn't jelled, while Eisenhower quarterback Jeff Stevenson is
