Racers will prove running's for birds

Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation and the San Marino Golf Course once again will prove that running's for the birds.

As in last year's race, the bird in question is the prize in the 2nd annual turkey trot.

This year's contest will begin at 10 a.m. at San Marino Golf Course, 26634 Halstead, between Grand River and Twelve Mile.

Registration will begin the day before the race at the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department, 31555 Eleven Mile. In site registration will begin at 9 a.m., the day of the race at San Marino Golf Course.

There will be two racing categories, competitive and joggers with a total of 14 different age categories.

In the competitive division, group one, boys and girls 10 years old and younger will run ½ mile beginning at 10 a.m. In group two, boys and girls, 11-13-years-old will run for a mile beginning at 10:15 a.m.

Boys and girls 14-15-years-old will begin their two mile long race at 10:30 a.m.

Boys and girls 16-17-years-old and men and women more than 18-years old will run three miles beginning at 11 a.m.

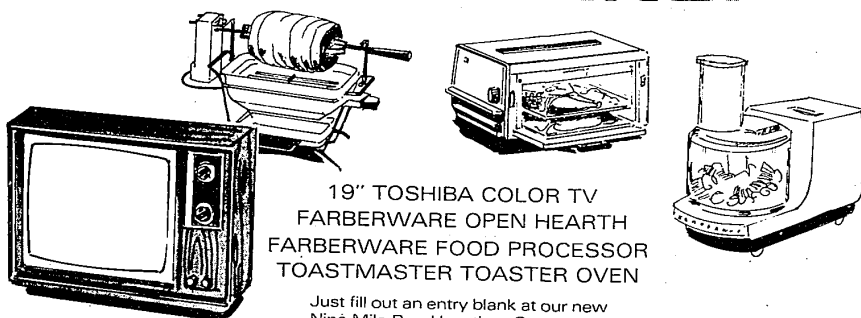
