# The nuts and bolts of 'Headlee' The personal income of Michigan (PIM) is defined by the proposal as the total income received by persons in Michigan from all sources as reported by the IJ.S. Department of Commerce. Federal aid is excluded in calculating this inpome. If the economy expands and personal income grows, the legislature would eutomatically have more money to work with because it is receiving a percentage of this income, but the legislature cannot increase its percentage without a vote of the people.

Proposition E Headlee Amendment

The issue: Should the State constitution be amended to limit all state tixes and revenues to their current proportion of total state personal income?

'The state constitution presently septimes an annual balanced state budget, and limits the property tax rute that may be levied by local units of government without a vote of the sooke. Local units of government sets or required by law to have a balgaced budget.

'Many taxpayers feel that government bureaucracy is growing too rep-

idly, and the increase in state spending is far out of proportion to the increase of the personal income of the people of Michigan.

Petitions filed by Taxpayers United, Inc. would amend the constitution by limiting the ability of the legislature to increase state taxes beyond their current proportion of the total personal income. This is a tax limitation covering all taxes in the State of Michigan, not a cut.

Many opponents feet the proposal is too restrictive and could cause vital services to be cut.

The proposal would limit state taxes and spending to a percentage—determined by the state budget for fiscal year 1970, and expected to be between 515 and 9,48 per cent—of the state's personal income.

Although the proposal excluded taxes authorized for repayment of principal and interest of existing moded indebtedness, new bonding would require water approval. The proposal does not guarantee that individual pieces of property will remain the same; the limit is on the total valuation for the municipality. Under the Headlee amendment, the state would be prohibited from adopting new or expanding present local programs without full state funding (to prevent shifting the burden to the local level). Also, total state spending for local units of government as a group cannot be reduced below the proportion spent into 78-79 fiscal year. 
