When I took my newborn, uncircum-rised son home from the hospital a few inouths ago, I was told to be sure to pull back the foreskin and clean the head of his penis when I bathed him. But my haby's foreskin wouldn't retract. Would you please discuss this in your column, along with the medi-cal reasons for routine directions.

The American Academy of Pediatrics has repeatedly taken the strong stand that there is no medical justification for "routine" circumerison of the newborn. It has been estimated that 80 per cent of newborn makes in this country are subjected to this surgical procedure annually at a cost of 60pt 750 million.


