Area coffeehouses co-sponsir festival

A Detroit Folk and Blues Festival will be co-sponsored by three nonprofit coffeehouses—the *hinge*, Common Ground, and Undercurrent—on Sunday, Oct. 29 from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Recreation Organization Center of the University of Michigan-Dearborn.

Performers from the festival will contribute to the local folk and blues coffeehouses. Admission is free, with donations encouraged.

Concert headliners include Rowena Bailey, a member of the band of Detroit folk guitar and banjo; and Dean Rutledge, a professional who started performing in area coffeehouses in the mid-1960s. He is playing back then as Chuck Mitchell were all part of a thriving folk community.

A variety of other musicians also will be performing, including Walker King, a folk artist in the tradition of Guthrie and Seeger who is named for his cross-country strolls to California and back; and a duo, including Walker and banjo player, Joe Vermillion, known for his large repertoire and knowledge of folklore; Michelle Authier, contemporary folk; Kathy Lathery, traditional and contemporary folk; and a duo of traditional folk and folkore specialists who accompany themselves with mandolin, pennywhistle, steel guitar, harmonica and piano.

"The purpose of the festival," according to Hinge Coordinator Tim Joy, "is to make people aware of the folk scene in Detroit, to promote local coffeehouses and to bring Detroit artists to listening audiences in the area."

Performers will play back then music in comparative non-competitive style. They will be able to perform in the intimate and relaxed environment of coffeehouses.




