"The mediators," she said, "would render a money award. If the parties reject the award, the matter can go to trial. If the judge's award varies less than 10 per cent from the mediator's award, the party rejecting the award would be assessed with a stiff financial posalty." penalty.

Mrs. Gage predicted that such a system would be successful and would free up more courtroom time.

Arbitrators, she said, could also be used to handle many divorce cases.

Not only would the system require the consent of the Michigan State Supreme Court, she said, but once in practice it would require the consent of both parties.
