"Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are

"Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are Dead" by Tom Stoppard will open Friday Nov. 24. at 8:39 p.m. in Wayne Sate University's Studio Theatre-kownstairs at the Hilberry.

The play will run at 8:30 p.m. Seturday, Nov. 25, and the following week, Wednesday-Saturday, Nov. 29-Dec. 2. with a Sunday performance Nov. 26 at 7:30 p.m. For this play, Stoppard has taken two of Shekespeare minor characters—Hamlet's school friends Rosencaratz and Guildenstern—and lax elevated them to the center of action, while Hamlet, Ophelia. Claudius and Polonius take the secondary roles. The London Observer's Ronald Dryden called this play "the most billiant dramatic debut of the sxites."







