**Artisans Gallery**—This Southfield gallery will show art by Jill Purdie through Dec. 17. Wine and cheese reception, 7-9 p.m. Friday. The gallery is at 19566 W. Ten Mile, Southfield.

**Odyssey Gallery**—Cibachrome prints by Monte Nagler of West Bloomfield will be on display at this Twelve Oaks Mall gallery in Novi through December. Cibachrome color photographs have a mirror-like finish and extraordinary color saturation. Nagler is a Farmington businessman who does all of his own processing and printing in this avocation.
