Top soccer talent picked

The growth of high school soccer in the area made a strong surge upward this year as three other Livonia high schools added teams to compete along with Livonia Stevenson.

The squads competed in the North Suburban Soccer League West Bracket and did surprisingly well. Livonia Bentley was second in the league behind Ann Arbor.

Greenhills, Stevenson, the veteran team, was tied with Bentley in the standings (each team had a 5-1 record).

Livonia Churchill completed the season with a 2-4-1 mark, while Livonia Franklin was 0-6-1. Farmington, another area school, accumulated a 5-2-0 record.

Bloomfield Andover became the state soccer champs, while the Bulldogs were third in the state behind second-place Detroit Country Day.

Through consolation, the area coaches picked 12 representatives from among those in the West Bracket.

ROBERT DINICOLA a senior from Stevenson has played with the Spartans for two seasons. Dinicola was a member of the 1977 state championship team at Stevenson and a member of the Michigan Youth Major Division championship squad last year. This year he competed on the Bonanza-Express 17 and under championship team.

JOE KOLODZIEJ, another senior from Stevenson, finished his third year for the Spartans contingent. Kolodziej was on the only state soccer crown team that Stevenson ever produced in 1976. He was also on the Bonanza-Express 17-and-under squad with teammate Dinicola. He plays at a striker position.

Kolodziej received an honorable mention on the 1978 all-state soccer squad.

DAVE STRANDQUIST completed his first year at Stevenson as a sophomore but will not doubt be a major factor for the Spartans in the coming

seasons. Strandquist netted 12 goals for Stevenson as a striker.

ROB LANG was the final Stevenson player chosen for the all-area team. He is a junior and collected 20 goals with the Spartans. He also played for the Bonanza-Express 17-and-under team where he tallied 15 goals.

JIM DUGGAN was Bentley's leading scorer throughout the 1978 season. He collected seven goals and 17 assists as an inside striker. Duggan is a senior and also competed on the championship 17-and-under team in the Bonanza-Express League.

STEVE O'CONNOR won the most valuable player award at Bentley this fall. The team captain played at center halfback. He was with a 1977 Western Suburban Soccer championship team. O'Connor is a senior.

STEVE ZIMMERMAN proved his worth in the goal for the Bentley unit. The senior collected

eight shutouts and let in only 11 goals in 13 games. Zimmermann was also chosen for the second team of the all-state squad.

JOHN TALBOT was the only area player to make the all-state first team. Talbot, a senior, was the strong man among the Bulldog's defensive line and, according to Bentley coach Paul Scicluna, was a very talented all-around player.

KYLE GNIEWEK was also a captain for this season's Bentley team. Gniewek was known best for his leadership both on and off the field.

BRIAN GUERIN was the only player from Churchill to make the all-area contingent. Guerin was the Chargers' co-captain.

TODD KAMSTRA led the Farmington team in scoring this fall with nine goals and seven assists. He was also the team captain and played as a sweeper. Kamstra is a senior.

R. CARTER RICHARDS was the other key sweeper on the Farmington team this year. Richards is a senior and played on the Bonanza-Express squad and the Western Suburban League championship teams in both 1977 and 1978.

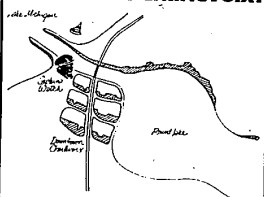

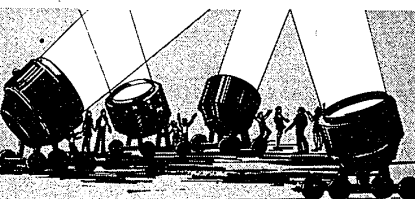
