An Oakland County Commissioner from Farmington Hills has been appointed to the National Association of Counties (NACO) Criminal Justice and Public Safety Steering Committee. Jack McDonald, 39, a third-term commissioner, was appointed by NACO President Charlotte Williams of Genesee County last month.




Common Cause approves of Brodhead's spending


