GINGERER FAD HOUSE

To make the gingerbread dough assemble the following ingredients:

**cup solid white vegetable shortening

**cup solid purper four (stited)

The recipe makes one large house or about 4-5 small ones. Assemble house using Royal Icing (below).

ROYAL ICING

3 Tbs. meringue powder 1 pound confectioner's sugar (four cups) 6 Tbs. warm water

In a heavy duty mixer, beat all ingredients at medium speed for 7-10 minutes until icing forms stiff peaks. Keep icing stored in an air-tight ontainer. Needs no refrigeration. Whip up before using again. If dries out quickly so do not leave exposed to air. Keep decorator tip on damp towel during use to prevent hardering.

1. Bake each piece, making sure the windows, doors, et. are cut out before baking.
2. Cook baked pieces on a flat surface.
3. With pastry tube and royal icing, frost or decorate each piece as you desire. Except for the large house, decorate all pieces before assembling. The icing hardeness flats, so have candies, etc., ready to apply once the icing is put on the houser parts.

A. Once all the parts are decorated, squeeze a row of frosting onto the base or nord, the width and length of the house. It will look like a letter L. S. Pipe icing on the base and side edge of the end piece and the side piece, Bonding both edges makes a better fit.

8. Pipe ining onto the upper edges of the ends and one side wall thalf the house). Put one roof piece on, making sure it is set before letting go. Make sure it is in the right position to match up other half of the roof also. Hidd on to the roof for a minute or two so it will not side down. If you have it heavily decorated, the weight of it may make it harder to stay up and may cause you to hold it in place longer. DO NOT RUSH THIS STEP.

Repeat the process in Step. 8 with the other half of the roof. Again, do not rush. If you plan to use heavy decorations on the roof, it might be best to decorate it after the roof has set for several hours.

10. Pipe all edges to cover the seams. Licorice can be used nicely here for some added detail.
