

Home health care service is alternative to consider

Joan had surgery recently. Her hospital stay is over, but she still needs lots of bed rest. But how can she get it with a couple of active preschoolers? Grandmother had a stroke. It was decided she should go home instead of to a nursing home, but her left side is partially paralyzed and she can't really manage alone. Who can help?

Bill and Ann have a seriously-ill child. He needs a lot of extra care, and Ann wants to provide it, but there are other children in the family and household chores demanding her attention. Is there any way she can get help?

Aunt Emma lives alone in a big house. She manages quite well, but her eyesight is failing and it's hard for her to read her mail and do some of her household routine. She gets lonely, too. Is there someone who could be there a few hours a day?

Whatever the situation, she said, the service that can be offered by agencies like hers is less costly than comparable care would be in a hospital or a nursing home.

"And very often there is a psychological benefit, too," Ms. Anzalone added. "People just seem to make better progress toward recovery when they are at home."

A further cost-saving factor, she said, "is that with home health care you can get and pay for exactly the service you need."

Men as well as women are part of the Upjohn staff and they are kept busy in administering several paramedical services and performing as companions.

MRS. ANZALONE, who emphasized that the service she is discussing is "not a substitute for hospital care, just an alternative that should be considered," comes from a hospital and nursing environment.

Before taking over her present post in 1976, she was associate executive director of the Florida Nurses Association, and in that capacity received a special recognition award for her part in revision of Florida law on licensure and scope of nursing practice.

She also has been assistant chief of nursing service for Manhattan Veterans Administration Hospital in New York, project director of nursing services for Michael Reese Hospital in Chicago, hospital nurse consultant for the Illinois department of health and consultant for medical products specializing in inhalation therapy for Linde Division of Union Carbide Corp.

A graduate of St. John Hospital School of Nursing in St. Louis, she also has degrees from St. Louis University School of Nursing and Columbia University.

REGISTERED NURSES, licensed practical nurses and home health aides are among the staff members sent out by the Upjohn firm.

Besides nursing services, they can serve as companions for the elderly, chronically ill or convalescing, function as home managers to handle shopping, meal planning and preparation as well as transportation to and from the doctor's office.

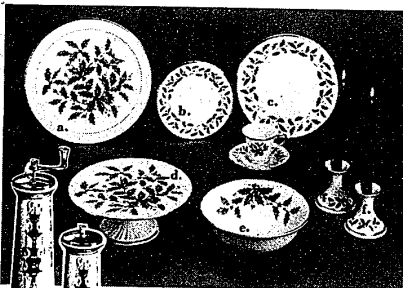
They also can be substitute mothers to care for children and give help for the handicapped and elderly. The staff, said Ms. Anzalone, can help prospective clients determine the type of service needed and the kind of person most qualified to provide it.

HEADQUARTERED in Kalamazoo and with offices in this area in Bloomfield Hills, Dearborn and Detroit, her firm has helpers available to lend a hand in a variety of situations when hospitalization or admittance to a nursing home seems not the right answer.

"We employ people who are skilled in caring for those with chronic illness or recovering after an accident or needing special help for any of a number of reasons," Ms. Anzalone said in an interview.

"These people can come on a full-time or part-time basis. Sometimes they come in to stay with the person who is ill for short periods while the family member can spend more time with the person who is ill."

"Sometimes they may mainly offer companionship to persons who can't really stay alone."

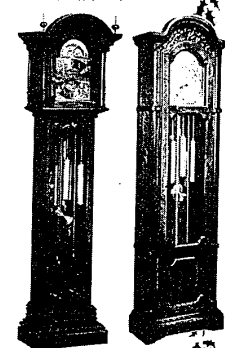

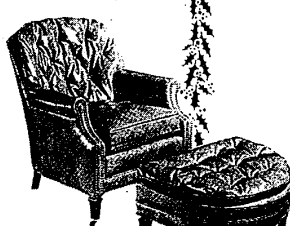

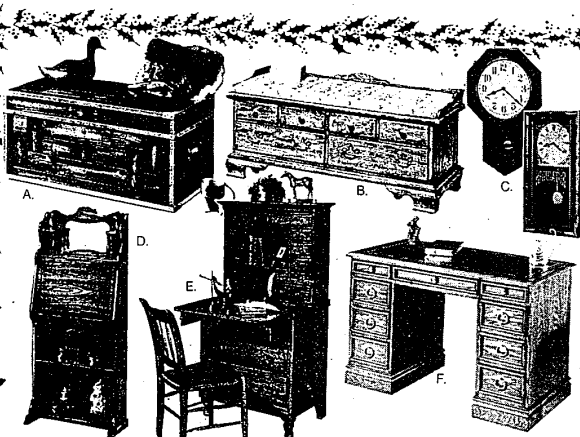
