The "King of Soul," Ray Charles, will sing his greatest hits at Detroit's Music Hall. Backed by the Raeletts and the Ray Charles Orchestra, Ray Charles' revue opens Dec. 26 and will wrap up with a special New Year's Eve show.

At age 48, Ray Charles has become a legend in his own time. He has dipped into more styles of music than almost any other singer and has come out with a kind of "soul" that reaches out to everyone, breaking all barriers of language, culture and education. Frank Sinatra once stated, "Ray Charles is the only genius in our business."

Winner of 10 Grammy awards, Ray Charles was selected by the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sci-ences (1975) as winner of the "Best R & B Vocal Performance—Male" cate-gory for his single of Stevie Worder's "Living for the City."

That same year Ray Charles was presented the Golden Plate Award by the American Acidemy of Achievement. In 1976 Ray Charles was named Best Jazz Mall Vecalist in the Playboy Magazine Music Awards Readers' Poll and was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame in New York.
