PETER MOSS, the festival's director-Third Stage, will direct "The First Part of Henry IV," to be presented at the Festival Theatre. Moss was the director of "The Merry Wives of Wind-

sor" and co-director of "The Winter's Tale" this year, in addition to his work at the Third Stage which included direction of Sheidon Rosens". "Ned and Jack" and Beckett's "From An Abandomed Work."

Tony Award winner Burt Shevelove, in his first association with the festival, will direct the world premiere of his own musical adaptation of the Philip Barry Blay, "Haidisy."

The production will be presented on the Avon stage. This new version of Jearry's popular comedy will include previously little-known songs by Cole Porter, gleaned from other musicals and revues.

Collibretist of "A Funry Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum,"
