

Salem matmen top Canton tourney

Three of the top wrestling teams in the area batted hard to win the Plymouth Canton Wrestling Invitational last weekend. Plymouth State, Redford Thurston and Warren Lincoln were the tournament favorites at the day-long competition. And as predicted, those three squads took the top honors.

Salem won the tourney by a wide margin with 181 points in front of second-place Lincoln with 157. Thurston was next with 147 points.

Dearborn took fourth position, while the Canton and West Bloomfield tied with 69

points each. Birmingham Seaholm was seventh with 35 points and Redford Bishop Borgess completed the field in last with 15 points.

"I thought the whole tournament went very well. It was a super good tournament," said Canton coach and tournament director Dan Chrenko. "I was very impressed with Salem. They showed the power they have."

Salem placed a wrestler in the final four in every weight class but two—145 pounds and 155 pounds.

Thurston the defending champion from last year's event had a slow start in the opening rounds of the com-

petition was never quite able to recover.

Canton, the host team, only had 10 players with which to wrestle and did about as well as coach Chrenko expected.

"I'm not at all disappointed. We had a couple of disappointments in some areas and a couple of surprises also. As a team we exposed our weakness for us not enough people," Chrenko said. "Dave Bennett at 132 pounds was a big surprise for us (Bennett won the weight division). He did a real nice job."

The tournament went through several stages before reaching the finals that night. Each

player wrestled through two or three rounds with the losers falling into the consolation brackets. It was a double elimination tournament which, according to Chrenko, is not unusual in wrestling tournaments.

The Rocks finished the day with four individual wins and a couple of championships, while Lincoln had four champions and Thurston three. Canton and Dearborn each had one tournament champion.

For Salem, Jeff Brown won the 112-pound weight class, Mark Ross won the 126-pound class, Jerry Valchene won the 130-pound division and Joe Piccola captured the 165-pound class.

Tom Arsenault was

first in the 98-pound division for the Eagles of Thurston, while Craig Schauder won the 145-pound class and Bob Otsinger was first in the 178-pound class.

West Bloomfield's best finishers were Brian Faudman and Howard Stone. Faudman lost to Ron Perry of Lincoln in the finals of the 155-pound class. Stone was third in the 98-pound division.

Mike Cunningham and Mark Carmen were the best finishers of the day for Seaholm. Cunningham lost in the consolation match of the 112-pound division, while Carmen lost in the consolation match of the heavyweight class.

Brain Salta and Paul VanZandt made the best showing of the day for Borgess. Salta lost in the consolation match of the 98-pound class, while VanZandt lost in the consolation match of the 126-pound division.

"As a team we had two of our 10 kids in the finals and four in the consolation matches and I think that was pretty darn good. I would have liked to place higher in our own tournament but that was not the most important thing."

"This tournament was designed to give the teams a chance to work out during the holiday break," continued the coach. "Also what we wanted was to get strong schools and schools that

we normally would not wrestle and put them together to benefit the wrestlers and give the fans something different."

"It was a good tournament. Our kids did an outstanding job," said Salem coach Ron Krueger. "We are striving for improvement from last season. Last year we were second in the tournament this year we were first."

"Our wrestlers did what they had to do to win the tournament. All in all it was our best day so far this year."

Krueger also said that to beat both Lincoln and Thurston in any tournament is a great honor.

"Salem, Warren and Thurston were the strongest teams at the tournament."
