

Shakespearean program visiting U-M

Nicholas Pennell, Marti Maraden and Tom Wood will appear for two performances of their touring show "This Fair Child of Mine" at 8 p.m. Friday and Saturday in the University of Michigan Truitt Theatre.

An all-Shakespearean program about parents and children, "This Fair Child of Mine" features three actors who are veterans of the Shakespeare Festival Theatre at Stratford, Ont.

The Milwaukee Journal praised this production as "the best demonstration of classical acting in many years" and called Pennell's voice an "international treasure."

Pennell has made numerous appearances as guest-artist-in-residence for the Professional Theatre Program at Ann Arbor, most recently in "Rogues and Vagabonds" with Marti Maraden last season.

DURING HIS seven seasons at Stratford, Pennell has assumed a wide variety of roles, among them Urbain Grandier in "The Devils," Brutus in "Julius Caesar," Victor in "Private Lives" (all during the 1978 season); the title roles in "Hamlet" and "Pericles"; and leading roles in "All's Well," "The Stoops to Conquer," "Two Gentlemen of Verona" and "The Importance of Being Earnest."

His stage roles also have carried him to England for performances in London's West End, the Oxford Playhouse and the Bristol Old Vic. Pennell's television career has seen him play leading roles in more than 200 productions, among them BBC's highly acclaimed series, "Porsythe Saga."

His film credits include "Battle of Britain," "Isadora" and "David Copperfield."

Theatergoers who have traveled to Stratford will recognize Ms. Maraden for her performances there during the last five seasons as a member of the acting company.

Critically acclaimed for her portrayals, Ms. Maraden has appeared as Ophelia in "Othello," Juliet in "Romeo and Juliet," Miranda in "The Tempest," Cecily in "The Importance of Being Earnest," Sonya in "Uncle Vanya," Perdita in "The Winter's Tale" and Irina in "The Three Sisters."

MS. MARADEN also has performed on numerous stages elsewhere in Canada, including the Vancouver Playhouse, the Frederick Wood, Bastion and Neptune Theatres and the Manitoba Theatre Centre. Her television credits include "The Beachcombers" and "Telescope" for CBC.

Tom Wood has appeared in productions at Stratford during the last two seasons, performing in "The Merry Wives of Windsor," "The Winter's Tale" and "Devotion" during the 1978 season.

Prior to his work at Stratford, Wood, a graduate of the University of Alberta, performed in Edmonton's Citadel Theatre in productions of "Romeo and Juliet" as Mercutio, "The Rivals" as Faulkland and "The Alchemist" as Face.

He was a 1975-76 member of the Playhouse Theatre Company in Vancouver where he played Alan Strang in "Equus" and King Peter in "Leon and Lena." He also has performed with Halifax's Neptune Theatre, Theatre Calgary and the New Play Centre in Vancouver.
