

Groves dumps Berkley

Lahser rips Maples, 78-46

Bloomfield Hills Lahser lifted its record to 7-1 by trouncing Birmingham Seaholm, 78-46, in a non-league basketball game Tuesday at Seaholm.

The Knights, ranked seventh in Class A, toyed with the 1-7 Maples much of the game.

Senior guard Rob Fodor led all scorers with 20 points. Forward Shawn Santa, a senior, added 17 while 6-8 senior center Scott Pritchett had 14 points and 18 rebounds.

Seaholm did not have a player in double figures.

Lahser jumped out to a 42-26 half-time lead and doubled the lead from that point at the final buzzer.

The Knights hawked Seaholm with a man-to-man defense the whole game. That pleased Lahser head coach Nick Conti.

"Defensively we played well as a unit," he said.

The Knights travel to Southfield-Lathrup Thursday in a showdown between the two top teams in the Metro Suburban Activities Association.

JOHN JONES exploded for 41 points to spark Bloomfield Hills Roper to an easy 93-41 win over Northwest Lutheran.

The 6-3 senior swingman hit 17 field goals and was perfect from the foul line (7-7).

"Jones just kind of took over," said Roper coach Dave McDonald.

Jones broke out of a slight slump. Last Tuesday against Detroit Country Day, he was limited to two points.

Besides his 41-point outburst, Jones collected 15 rebounds and had six assists.

Other Roper players in double figures were Carlos Goodman (14) and senior guard Steve Mitchell (10).

Roper is 5-3 overall and travels to the Flint Open on Monday.

BIRMINGHAM GROVES snapped a three-game losing streak with a 68-63 come-from-behind victory over Southeastern Michigan Association member Berkley Tuesday night.

The Falcons, now 5-5 overall, got balanced scoring led by senior forward Ted Williams (18), 6-6 forward Naim Peress (11) and guard Tom Fletcher (13).

Groves broke out of its slump with a big fourth quarter. They outscored Berkley, 25-12, in the last quarter to secure the victory.

The Falcons had trailed at halftime, 30-26, and at the end three quarters, 51-43.

Groves however beat Berkley at the foul line, hitting 22 of 36 shots. Berkley

was guilty of playing too aggressively and committed 25 fouls. Three Berkley players fouled out.

Both teams rebounded evenly. Peress led Groves with 10 boards while 6-7 center Mark McManus added nine.

Guard John Galecki had eight assists for Groves.

The Falcons travel to Royal Oak Dondoro on Friday for a Metro Suburban Activities game.

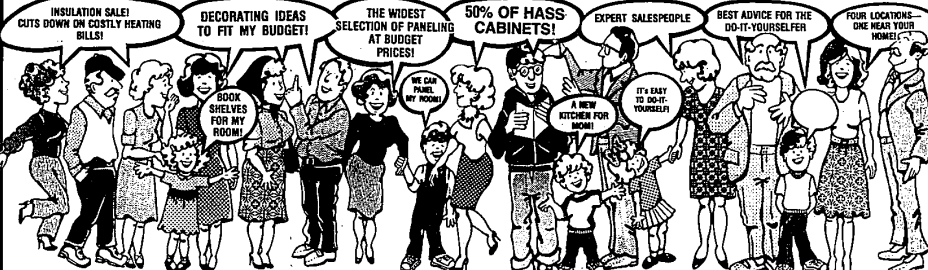
