House Dems unveil tax relief plans

Michigan House Democrats, who took much of the heat during last summer's tax revolt, have put "proper-ty tax relief" at the top of their laundry list.

list.
House Speaker Bobby Crim (D-Davison) and Majority Floor Leader Joseph Forbes (D-Southfield) vowed a new tax system during the new legislative session that began last week.

system during the new legislative ses-sion that began last week. According to Crim and Forbes, relief will come by expanding Michigan's "circuit-breaker" program. Crim said, "shready has the most extensive and expensive cir-cuit-breaker property tax relief pro-gram in the country. Yet the voters have told us if not enough." Forbes added, "To meet the chal-lenge of property tax relief, we have to have a major expansion of the circuit-breaker."

THAT EXPANSION, under the Dem-ocratic plan, will mean senior citizens and the disabled will qualify for a 100 per cent property tax rebate. Other "general taxpayers" will get a 75 per cent rebate.

Under the present circuit-breaker, there are six different scales governing the size of your property tax rebate. While a new circuit-breaker formula lias not been determined, House Demo-cratic researchers promise a "consid-erably more simplified system."

"The new formula will give significantly more relief to persons earning \$10,000 to \$30,000." one House researcher said.

Orim and Forbes proposed increasing the personal income exemption to at least \$1,800 per person. The éxemption now is \$1,500.

They also proposed that the property tax allowance for renters be increased from 17 per cent to 20 per cent.

"PROPERTY TAX relief will mean a tax break for some and a tax shift for others.
