## Artist group sponsors contest for students

Entry forms are now available for students wishing to participate in the annual student show of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Art Association (BBAA).

Two shows have been scheduled for this year, the first being Feb. 10 through March 3, the second from May 12 to June 2.

All students in adult, teen and youth divisions enrolled in summer, fall winter and spring terms during 1978-79 are eligible.

Works must have been done during that time and reflect class experience. Entry forms are available at the BBAA, 1516 South Cranbrook, Birmingham 48069.

Entries for Student Show I are due by hand delivery to the BBAA from Jan. 26 to Feb. 1. They can be dropped off from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., except Sunday. Pieces for the second show can be turned in April 28 to May 4.

Media eligible for Student Show I is oil, acrylic painting, drawing, sculpture, jewelry, enameling and stained glass. Media eligible for Student Show II consists of watercolor painting,

fibers, ceramics, calligraphy, photography, design, printmaking and all youth work.

Adults will be charged a \$2 fee per entry and entrants may submit a maximum of three entries per medium. There will be no charge for youth and teens.

All adults will be submitted for jury. The juror for Student Show I is Arthur Greenblatt, dean of the center for cre-

ative studies.

Student Show II jury will be Lee Ann Miller, chairman of art and art history department for Wayne State University. Youth and teen works will not be juried. A maximum of two works per youth or teen entrant will be hung as space allows.

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the jury, with first prize of \$100. Second prize is a free BBAA class and third prize is \$50. Additional merit awards will be given.
