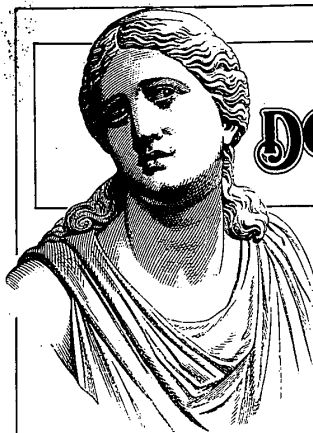
A pre-performance reception with light refreshments will begin at 7:45 p.m.
