al shapes. The artist will give a 9 a.m. lecture at Kingswood auditorium on Feb. 28. Reception to meet the artist from 2-4 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 2. The gallery is in Kingswood School, 885 Cranbrook, Bloomfield Hills.

CONTINUING SHOWS
Ed Gray Gallery—Works by five artists are featured at the gallery. One of the local artists, William J. MacArthur, is also an art teacher in the Bloomfield Hills School District. MacArthur, an award-winning painter, hasn't shown his work except in rare instances until now. Along with MacArthur's abstract and color band series, the gallery is showing handmade paper and lithos by Ann Marie Karlson, gold and silver jewelry by Birmingham artist Julie Shaw, watercolors by Stan Dudek, soft sculptures and Pierrot pint by Marie Ferrini and metal sculpture and fountains by Ed Gray. The three, discovered by academy director Roy Slade when he was in Brazil in 1977, are Genilson Soares, Francisco Inarra and Lydia Okumura. Detroit Institute of Arts—"The Second Empire: Art In France under Napoleon III" continues through March 18. The 362 paintings, sculptures, furnishings, textiles, decorative objects and period photographs, make up the largest exhibition to come to this area. The muse-

um, 5200 Woodward, Detroit, is open 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Tuesday-Sunday. Admission charge for this special exhibit.
