Jamison said.

MRS. JAMISON has been fascinated
with plants ever since her grandfather

introduced her to herb lore back home in Lancaster, Ohio. Her grandfather's grandfather was a herbalist in England.
"We're a plant family." she says "My mother is an excellent herb cool and my father knows all about wood land plants.

"We grew up on a farm and were all interested in herbs, although in the be-ginning we called them wild plants."

Her own interest in herbs led her ultimately to assisting in the planting of the now-famous herb gardens at Cranbrook, and she is known as "the hert lady" at Tweeney's, a Birmingham restaurant for gourmets.

"I grow the herbs at home or gather them from other growers" she said adding that there are about 30 herb growers now in the Detroit metropoli-tan area.

Mrs. Jamison is not a stranger to the

has given lectures there in the past, and
invited groups to her Bloomfield Hills

home for berb luncheons in cooperation with the center.
She's teaching a class there, called "The Magie of Herbs," which covers all aspects of herbs and spices. Participants are learning about garden design, growing methods, herbal history that goes back to the spice trade, the use of herbs in crafts, herb cookery, and the healing aower of herbs.


