

# In The Pocket

Contrary to the old tradition that bowling scores rise when the temperature falls, there were no barrier-breaking 700 series in the western suburbs during the past week.

Even John Hurley, who has been making a habit of posting 700 series in the Monday league at Westland Bowl, had to be content with a 649 count. It was only the second time in the past few weeks that he has failed.

Despite the low scores, there were some unusual performances. Among them was the contribution of Dave Kauppi in the Pinbusters League at Plaza Lanes. He staked a claim for consistency when he linked counts of 223, 223 and 234 for a 680.

Another unusual happening occurred in the Livonia Ladies Classic when three bowlers deadlocked in one of the three games. After Pat Reid had taken the first with 191-30-221 Dot Fulton, Mary Bierkamp and Lois Merriman tied at 295 in the second. Dot had 182-

23-205, Mary posted a 166-39-205 and Lois had a 182-23-205.

But their bid for the top failed when Liz Clement, a 120 average bowler, posted a 202-56-259 to win the third game and the series with 452-168-620.

ONLY 14 PINS separated the three top bowlers in the Little Caesar Classic at Westland Bowl. When the last pin fell, Mark Miloszewicz was out in front with a 691 made possible by a 247 opener. He was followed by Manny

Melendez, who had a 268 in 687, and Bob Shonce who closed with 238 for 677.

While John Hurley was failing to add another 700 series to his record in the Monday Morning League, Bob Rose took top honors with a 692. Dan McDaniels posted a 648 to tie with Hurley for second place.

In the women's doubles, Freda Spachowiak, who carries a 155 average, found the range for a 613 series on games of 211, 215 and 187. And in the

men's 850 League, Rick Raditz converted the 7-10 split.

DON GAVINK was high man in the St. Lins League at Garden Lanes. He battered the pins for games of 214, 233 and 229 for 667. In the Senior Citizens league, Rose McQueen, with a 115 average, came through with a 448. Jan Milan was high in the Proprietors Travelling League with a 596.

WITH A MIDDLE game of 225, Toni

Smith was able to post a 638 for top honors in the Merr-Bowl doubles. She beat out Kay Markell by 30 pins.

In the St. Andrew's loop, Jani Klatsowski used a 242 game to land on top with 555.

AT WOODLAND LANES Pat Sabo rolled a 235 for high single in the Belles League and finished with a 607. Next in line were Barb Dettorre with a 540 and Ada Prushkar with 515.

In the Gay Nineties circuit, Sandy De

Camillo showed the way with counts of 223 and 201 for 611. George Santa had a 525, Tom Chisolm a 517 and Cliff Kardenbrack, a 501.

IN THE MIXED CLASSIC at Farmington Lanes, Roger Adema came through with a 245 and a 635 series to take top place. Neil Beckman landed the runner-up spot with a 618.

In the Friday noon mixed competition, Diane Lawson was high with a 226 in 613 and Myrna Hille had a 230 in 578. In the Alley Katz loop, Rose Peterson posted a 240 in 633.

IN OTHER good performances, Karen Krejcar finished with a 223 to pace the Coffee and Toasters at Plaza Lanes with a 530. In the Motor Wheel League at Super Bowl, Fred White fashioned a 290 and in the Friday men's loop Don Jacobb had a 279.

Wes Shasko was high man in the classic with 674. Others who fashioned double century games were Mike Carter with a 254 in 645, Don Weise with 633, Mike Manolakis with 631 and Dan Pedrys with 630.
