Programs warm up for winter

Program registration begins Feb. 23 at the Farmington Community Library. Both branches are offering a wide variety of programs for children of all ages.

From 9 a.m.-11 a.m., registration must be completed in person at either branch library. After 11 a.m., phone registrations will be accepted.

Preschoolers may register for "Big Bird's Bash" plus one five week program: "Science for Tots," "A Tisket, a Tasket, a Storyteller's Basket," or "Music for Young Moderns," at the Farmington branch on Liberty.

At the Farmington branch also will

be Writers in Training (WIT) for first and second graders; "Monster Mash" for third and fourth graders; "Green Thumb Fun" and "Bulletin Boards" for fifth and sixth graders. Each of the last two programs meet twice.

At the Farmington Hills branch on Twelve Mile, preschoolers can register for "Big Bird's Bash" in addition to a regular five week program: "A Tisket, a Tasket, a Storyteller's Basket," "Start with Art," "Science for Tots" or "The Best Goes on with Music." First and second graders can join "Stone Soup" while Writers in Training will be presented for third and fourth graders.

A special program, held for one session for fifth and sixth graders is "Me-Shift, T-Shirts."

ALSO, "READER'S ROUND-UP" is offered for fifth and sixth graders.

As with all registration required programs at the Farmington Community Library, Farmington and Farmington Hills residents are given first preference. Children shouldn't sign up for the same programs they attended in January through February. If a child wants to sign up for a second program, or if he's from outside Farmington, his name will be placed on a waiting list.

PARENTS MAY ATTEND a "Trip to the Orient" with their preschool children from 10:30 a.m.-11 a.m., Feb. 22 in the Farmington Hills branch. Oriental films of fairy tales, finger games and simple paper folding will be featured.

"Feline Frolics" will feature cat movies from 2 p.m.-2:30 p.m., March 5 at the Farmington Hills branch.

"To Care, to Share" will feature two films: "The Shopping Bag Lady" and "Big Henry and the Polka Dot Kid" for school aged children from 2 p.m.-3 p.m. on Feb. 24 at the Farmington Hills branch. Registration is unnecessary.

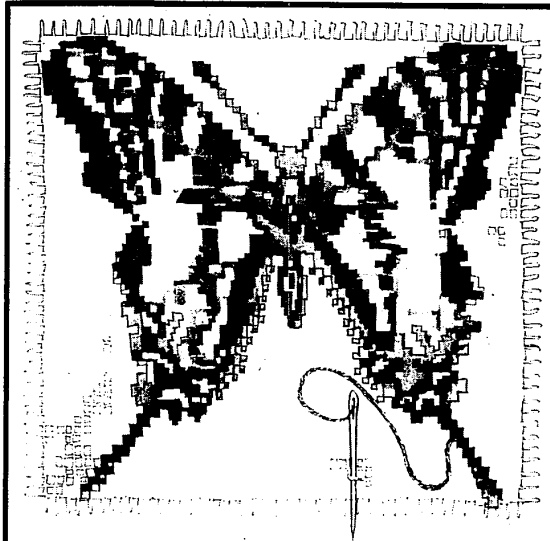

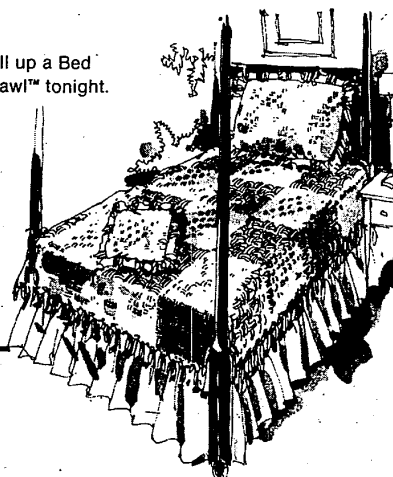
