Republican delegates in Cobo Hall quietly voted in favor of it, 979-313. Only he 2nd Congressional District consisting of Livonia, Plymouth, Northville, eastern Washtenaw County and Monroe county — opposed it among suburban districts. The vote was 44-37 against in the 2nd but 69-8 in favor in the 12th District (Rochester and Macomb County) and 71-31 in the 19th (western Oakland).

All suburban districts strongly op-posed a question on banning "all contri-butions for state and local public office other than those made directly by individuals."

State Rep. James Defebaugh (R-Bir-mingham) argued "it will hurt our par-
