He chaired the party's Winograd Commission on rules reform, and he is president of the Association of State Democratic Chairs.

His right-hand lady will continue to be Olivia (Libby) Maynard of Flint, who was reelected vice-chairman. Mrs. Maynard returns to party work after an unsuccessful bid for lieutenant governor as the running mate of gubernatorial nominee William Fitzgerald.
