HUNTERS can circle Aug. 15 on the calendar Put-lake pheasant season opens that day from 8 am. to 2 p.m., (except in the Bald Mountain Area, where it opens Labor Day).

Season runs through Nov. 14 and then reopens from Dec. 1-31. It's expected to be a good hunt because the state DNR plans to release 120,000 pheasants by the end of December.

One tip: Scout potential hunting areas and meet landowners to request permission now — don't be part of the horde on opening day.

The rules on hunting licenses, public access permits and put-lake permits are complicated, so get a copy of the rules at the place where you buy your license.

STONV CREEK Lake is still closed to swimming, but nine holes of the new 18-hole polf course at his metropark near Rochester are now open. The other nine holes will be opened within a few weeks, according to the Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority (HCMA).

Purpose of a concession is to conserve public funds and bring in private funds to help develop the metroparks.


