


Group reports contributions



The Oakland County Volunteer Bureau, a- program of the Volunteer Action Center of United Community Services, has weekly listage of volunteer opportunities. Further information about these and other volunteer needs at over 200 agencies may be obtained by calling the bureau at 642-2727. Any non-profit organization needing volunteer assistance may also call the bureau.

CITIZEN ADVOCATE - Teens and adults are needed to serve as friends to mentally retarded citizens in this program sponsored by Oakhad County Association for Retarded Citizens. Volunteers are given basic training and asked to attend periodic meetings. This would be primarily an evening or weekend commitment of two hours a week.

SPORTS INSTRUCTOR - Male volunteers with physical education train-ing, teaching experience or a strong background in sports are needed by the Jewish Community Center in West Bloomfield for its fall program. 
