Guitar player gives concert

Wilbert Longmire, a "graduate" of the Wes Montgomery school of guitar playing, and Dave Sporney's Big Band, made up of 17 northern Michigan big band musicians, will play at Chuck Muer's P Jazz at Detroit's Hotel Pontchartrain.

Longmire will appear Monday, Aug. 20, while Sporney's band is slated for Wednesday, Aug. 22.

Longmire and his ensemble also reflect the influence of Oscar Peterson, Ahmad Jamal, Miles Davis and John Coltrane in their technique and music phrasing.

Earlier in his career, Longmire played in his native Cincinnati with such major acts as Smokey Robinson and the Miracles, Gladys Knight and the Pips, Jerry Butler and other rock 'n' roll groups.

THROUGH THE COACHING and advice of million-seller George Benson, Longmire progressed to his own group in 1975. After much rehearsal and hibernation to find the direction he wanted to take in music, his first Columbia Records album, "Sunny Side Up," was released in 1977.

His concert begins at 8 p.m. Aug. 20, with reserved seats and general admission tickets available.

Dave Sporney, lead trombonist for his big band ensemble, is an instructor at the Interlochen Arts Academy. He has played with the Andy Williams, Nancy Wilson, Bob Hope and Johnny Mathis shows during his career.

In addition, he has through the years performed alongside such immortals as Benny Goodman, Joe Williams and Dizzy Gillespie.

Graduates of the Sporney Big Band have gone on to play with the Stan Kenton and Maynard Ferguson bands, among others.

The Dave Sporney Big Band concert begins at 6 p.m. on Aug. 22. Ticket prices are for reserved seats and for general admission.

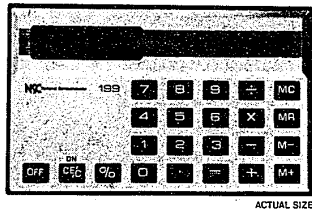

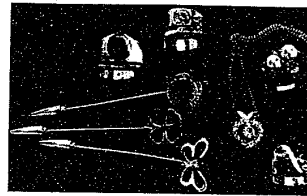
