

Musical Drama Premieres At Institute

A special hour-long musical-drama, "Young Martin Luther King Jr.," will have its mid-western premiere at the Detroit Institute of Arts Theatre Saturday, Nov. 15, in two public performances.

Presented by the Detroit Youth Theatre, the original show is an extraordinary stage experience for junior and senior high schoolers.

THE PRODUCTION IS PART

of the New York Performing Arts Repertory Theatre's "Preludes to Greatness" series, which depicts famous Americans and the circumstances which made them great.

"Young Martin Luther King Jr.," follows Dr. King's career from his early days as a pastor in Montgomery, Ala., through his years as a brilliant leader of American civil rights.

It concludes with his assassination in 1968.

Dr. King's major confrontation in the musical-drama is the Alabama bus boycott of 1955. Another dramatic plot incident is his meeting his wife-to-be, Coretta, at Boston University Graduate School.

The Southern Christian Leadership Conference and Mrs. Coretta King have given unanimous approval to the script. Credit for the original book and lyrics goes to O.G. Broadway playwright and novelist, Alice Childress.

"YOUNG MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR." was critically acclaimed at its New York opening this June and to Art Institute's Youth Theatre performance is the first outside the East Coast.

The part of Dr. King is played by Robert E. Hays-Hill, who recently finished an Off-Broadway run in the lead role of "Purple Heart." He alternates between acting and writing for stage and film, and is currently working on a script for the National Film Board in Montreal.
