## Indian museum added at Historic Fort Wayne

A major new museum facility of the Detroit Historical Department opened officially in July at Historic Fort Wayne. The Great Lakes Indian Interpretive Museum, located on the Fort's grounds, is devoted to the preservation of the history of the Northern Woodland Indians, with the Great Lakes as the principal focal point.

The museum adds an aspect to Historic Fort Wayne that has long been neglected. The many colorful and informative exhibits presented attempt to compress the complex beliefs, culture, technology and historical impact of the Algonquian and Iroquoian peoples into a factual and yet easily understood story that spans a period from

thousands of years before the birth of Christ to contemporary times.

The Great Lakes Indian Interpretive Museum is open to the general public during the regular hours of Historic Fort Wayne, 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday, and 11:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Sunday. Closed Monday and Tuesday.

No additional admission fees are charged over the regular Fort admission of \$1 for adults, 50 cents for senior citizens and teenagers, and 25 cents for those under 12.

Free parking is available. Historic Fort Wayne is at the foot of Livernois at West Jefferson. The telephone number is 849-0299 or 849-5783.
