W. Bloomfield Twp. Board approves M-275 plan

West Bloomfield residents who op-pose the extension of M-27s get a boost from two township trustees Men. But the West Bloomfield Township Board still voted 3-2 to support the lat-est highway plan. Clerk Betly Sue Dupree and trustees Weldon Yeager and Raymond Holland OX'ed a resolution urging the state transportation commission to build the highway.

Their support is for the latest modifi-

Inter support is for the latest modifi-cation to run from the intersection of 1-96 and 1-275 in Novi to 1-75 near Davis-burg, north of West Bloomfield. In voting against the resolution, trus-tees Dennis Vatsis and Thomas Law say the first priority is to upgrade ex-isting local roads.

isting local roads.

Two board members, Township Supervisor John Ooherty and Treasurer Marilyn Fessler, are on vacation.

Doherty is a strong advocate for extending M-275. Mrs. Fessler's views are unknown.

"I DON'T THINK the comunity wants rapid growth, (the) paving of tens of thousands (of acres) of concrete over farmhand, argued Vatis." For 20 or 30 years we have encouraged urbary sprawl. Our cities have decayed as a result, 'he said.

But Yeager says it (M-275) must be extended now before costs get higher, "if we're ever going to have any (traffic) relief and get an extension of Northwestern Highway. We have growth coming west."

Neva Carter, president of the West Bloomfield-Farmington Area League of Women Voters, oppseed the extension, saying she also spoke for all Oakland Courty LWV presidents.

"We can not understand your thinking in believing that M-275 will alleviate West Bloomfield's congested areas," she said. "You're talking about environmentally sensitive land, the headwaters of the Huron, Clinton and Rouge rivers.
"Support of M-275 does not reflect the sentiment of the entire township, Ms. Carter said. Many in this time of energy crisis feel that no new miles of

freeway should be built."

Law suggested upgrading local roads, making Maple Road a boulevard and extending Northwetern to Maple as alternatives to new construction.

But Holland said, "It's not jusj our problem; it's the county and state. M-275 doesn't directly affect the township but they aren't about to knock Northwestern through without it. "The people are here and more are coming," he emphasized.

THE STATE cancelled plans for M-275 and Northwestern Highway exten-sions in 1977. But proponents never gave up. The latest modification is one

along M-275, Vatsis says. "There's been a little cogniving, in my opinion." The township should be more con-cerned about local roads than "getting truck traffic to Flint," said resident Shiela Oatley, a former president of Concerned Citizens for West Bloom-field

field.

Bernadine Edwards, a West Bloomfield Parks and Recreation commissioner, called Southfield a "cement
canyon." She predicted the highway
would force the same congestion on
West Bloomfield.

Resident Lorna McEwen forecast
that in 10 years, if the highway is built,
people will move north from West
Bloomfield, continuing a pattern of urban sprawl.




