Kurt Holtschlag, 3, of Orchard Lake was honored as the youngest angler 12-15 who are getting their first hunting licenses.

The low-key contest is sponsored annually by the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission. Independence Oaks park is on Crooked Lake in Independence Township.

Librarians to hold Oakland workshop

The Oakland County Library Board and Oakland University are co-sponsoring an all-day workshop for librarians working in Oakland County.

The conference, "Sharing Resources," will be held on O.U.'s campus, Rochester, from 9-5 Saturday, Sept. 15.

The goal is to improve inter-library cooperation and understanding.

The conference will begin with the keynote speaker, Dr. Jean Lowrie, dean of the School of Libraryship at Western Michigan University. Dr. Lowrie also served as the chairperson of the Michigan White House Conference on Libraries and Information Services and is a delegate from Michigan to the Na-

tional White House Conference.

Participants will then break up into groups by type of library: public, academic, special and school libraries.

At a luncheon hosted by Oakland University, the featured speaker will be State Sen. Jack Faxon, D-Detroit. After lunch, the participants will be grouped into six geographical areas within the county to discuss concerns with other librarians working within these areas. The conference will close with a general meeting of all participants.

sis. MUCC President Glen Corbett of Harper Woods will open the proceedings on the State Capitol steps.

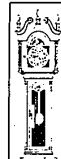
Purpose is to call attention to "the severe threat to Great Lakes fish stocks from unregulated gill netting by Indian commercial fishermen," Corbett said.

The core of the controversy is U.S. District Judge Noel Fox's May 7 decision that would allow the state's right to regulate the trout and salmon fishery. The state has spent millions creating the fishery after lamreys almost wiped it out in the 1950s.

Homemade banners saying "Save Our Fish" should be brought along, Corbett said.

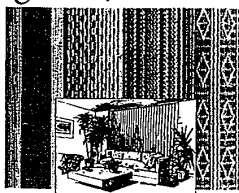
