

# Brodhead seeks New York support for coming battle over Chrysler aid

A suburban Detroit Congressman is asking New York to back Chrysler aid legislation.

Congressman William M. Brodhead, D-Detroit, has written to New York Senators Jacob Javits and Patrick Moynihan, New York City Mayor Edward Koch, and the state's 39-member House delegation, calling for their support for proposed legislation to assist the troubled corporation.

Brodhead recalled the Congressional vote in 1975 to provide federal assistance

to prevent a default by New York City. In that vote, which passed the House by a slim margin of 213-203, 15 Michigan Democrats and Republicans provided the winning margin.

"I believe that the issues involved in the two cases are very similar. In both instances, the problem has been made more difficult by federal programs and regulations and in both instances results of a failure would have serious national repercussions. Also in both cases substantial unemployment and massive disruptions of state and local government services are the central issues," said Brodhead.

He intends to mount an intensive campaign to insure passage of the proposed legislation backed by the administration to provide \$500-\$750 million in loan guarantees to financially-strapped Chrysler.

In addition to the appeal to the New York Congressional delegation, Brodhead indicated that he will make special appeals to house and senate members from states with large concentrations of Chrysler employees and with industries which supply the auto maker.

"THE CONSEQUENCES of a Chrysler shutdown would be even more grim for Michigan than a 1975 default

would have been for New York," Brodhead wrote.

"There are 85,000 Chrysler employees in Michigan and an additional 100,000 indirect jobs. Nationwide, the total number of jobs affected is possibly as many as half a million. The cost

in human terms is staggering, to say nothing of the billions of dollars lost tax revenues additional expenditures for welfare and unemployment compensation. In addition, you may be aware that Chrysler employs some 12,500 workers in the State of New York."

## Surplus goods to be auctioned

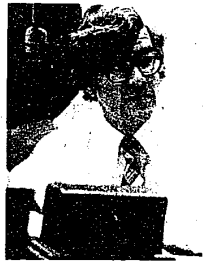
The surplus county goods on the bloc include three 18-foot fiberglass boats, with motors, two GMC vans and 15 passenger vehicles.
