• Most people regard color as a dominant fac-tor in decorating, but col-or is really just a reflec-tion of certain elements making up white light. White is a combination of all colors. Thus, a white object reflects all light. Black absorbs all color.

A TRICK employed by lighting designers is to in-

stall different kinds of lights on variable controls over a major area. This provides flexibility in manipulating color appearance by using one type of light or another

brightness or dimming it to a soft glow. Color and light work together to unify the home by co-ordinating the task.
