

Running fence

A controversial 1976 art project in California, an 18-foot high, 24.5-mile long white nylon fence traverse the countryside in the northern part of the state. The art work is the subject of "Running Fence," a one-hour program to be shown at 9 p.m. Oct. 22 on Channel 56, Detroit's public television station.

Lecture on Gaudi Sept. 13 at LIT

Herman Spiegel, professor of architectural engineering at Yale University and an award-winning structural engineer, will discuss the works of Spanish architect Antoni Gaudi during a special appearance at Lawrence Institute of Technology on Thursday.

Spiegel will be the first speaker in the LIT School of Architecture's Visiting Professional Lecture Series, which brings outstanding architects, designers, critics and engineers to the college's Southfield campus. The presentation will begin at 7:30 p.m. in the LIT architecture auditorium, 21000 Ten Mile in Southfield. It is free of charge and open to the public.

A former dean of architectural studies at Yale, Spiegel maintains one of the nation's most respected structural engineering practices. The firm's solutions to architectural problems have won numerous awards and citations including the Progressive Architecture Design Award in 1969 for the Kletna

residence in Seal Harbor, Maine, and in 1970 for the Genesee Gateway Housing in Rochester, N.Y. In addition, his firm was awarded the Design Award for the 31st National Conference on Religious Architecture in 1971 for the Trinity Church of the Nazarene in Orange, Conn.

Spiegel currently is serving as the structural consultant to George C. Izenour, theater designer, and has been involved in recent years with numerous restorations and renovations. These have included the Tide Mill Building in Southport, Conn., and the Schermerhorn Row Block Restoration in New York City.

Spiegel's illustrated presentation at LIT will center on the artistic aspects of Gaudi's architecture and how they relate to structural engineering. Gaudi, an architect whose works have been compared to the expressionist movement in painting and sculpture, is perhaps best known for his Casa Mila in Barcelona.

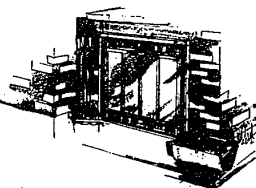
