Add expenses of travel, workers and other intangibles and it costs as much as \$6,000 for a horse like Darby Creek Road to come all the way from Califorroad to come all the way from Calliona. And that's a very conservative estimate. Sears then must decide handiaps. Some horses are allowed to carry less weight than others. Sears decides this by evaluating the horse's past performances. Sensitive Prince was assigned the heaviest weight at 123 pounds.

Action begins early on Saturday. The weeks and months of preparation are coming to a head. At 2 p.m., the first race is set to begin and 12,108 fans pour into the track, ready to bet more than \$250,000 dollars during the day.

JUST OVER 4½ hours later, the mile began Actually, the race has been 1½ miles since 1964. The necessity of lengthening the race came about when a horrible jam-up marred the 1958 mile. The distance was eventually

Twelve horses paraded to the post. The list included A Letter to Harry, last year's Mile winner; Hold Your Tricks; a Chicago entry; and Poverty Boy, a Detroit favorite.

Sensitive Prince was the listed favor-ite at 8-5. The odds on him dropped to a very heavy favorite 3-4 before post time. Prince Majestic was listed at 4-1, Darby Creek Road, 5-1.

It was a cool, sharp day. The track was dry and fast, with shadows length-ening due to the setting sun. The gates opened and the race was on to the screaming of the fans.

In winning, Sensitive Prince over-came a big jinx of favorites who have been upset. In 1966, Tom Rolfe, the 1965 national three-year-old champ ridden by Willie Shoemaker, was beat-en by Stanislaus, a 21-1 longshot. The next year, he was beaten by unknown

The most stunning upset came in 1968 when super horse Damascus, who had garnered almost every honor in '67, was upset by Nodouble.

PRINCE MAJESTIC , who placed second, paid \$4.40 and \$3.60. Sorry Lookin' finished third, a longshot that paid \$7.00 to show. A Letter to Harry finished fourth, failing to be the first horse to win two consecutive Miles.

Jockey Vasquez and owners Dennis Milne, Joseph Taub and Hilliary Boone accepted the traditional winner's tro-phy and roses.

"He's a speed horse — you can't reign him." said Vasquez, who rode two winners during the day. "He handled well, but not as well as I would have liked. It was a very consistent track. Prince has bad luck with horses like Affirmed, but he's still one of the top-bases in the country."
