A member of Detroit's Scarab Club for 40 years, he has recently had a one-man exhibit with Galerie de Boicourt in Birmingham during the early '70s, which highlighted his nude carwings. Since then his work is in the permanent collection of Birmingham's Sly Fox Restaurant.
