

# Check your colors with your clock

Human beings seem to be equipped with at least two very different kinds of internal clocks.

There are morning people. These are the types who bounce out of bed at dawn and jog five miles before breakfast. They tend to be healthy and wholesome and turn their lights off at 10 p.m.

Then, there are night people. This is the observation of Tom Doherty, design director for Naugahyde, the vinyl fabric that is widely used in the home as upholstery and wallcovering.

Interior design reflects both moods, Doherty noted.

There are morning colors. These are the sun colors of yellow, mimosa, white, grass green, tangerine, and strawberry.

Morning rooms have side expanses of glass and are filled with plants. Woven reed baskets, fresh-cut flowers, and such signs of nature are everywhere.

BUT THE NIGHT person feels most comfortable in a setting that reflects a slower starting but perhaps longer lasting nature. Space can be closed in, but still very comfortable, even snug.

Colors are dramatically different.

Where the morning person revels in clear, crisp hues, the night person favors smoky browns and earthtones, blues with lots of gray content, soft sea greens and celadons, gunmetal gray, and steely black and chrome. The look is frankly sophisticated.

Two kitchen designs offer a good example of the contrast in moods.

Sunlight floods the kitchen and breakfast room designed by Charlotte and Ving Smith of New Rochelle, N.Y. Plenty of glass and a southern exposure let an indoor garden flourish most of the year. Double thicknesses of glass encasing a layer of insulating air help prevent heat loss.

Easy-care furnishings and finishes are in bright colors. The table is copper. A woven white rug covers a golden cork floor. The plump sofa and ottoman are upholstered in Naugahyde "Decor" pattern in parchment white.

The manufacturers claim Naugahyde resists tears and scuffing because of its tough, laminated construction, is virtually fade-free, and it may be wiped clean with a damp cloth or even scrubbed with soap and water, if necessary.

When not in use, the dining table can be rolled to one side to become a sideboard or serving bar. The octagonal

stacking tables in the right foreground can be set out for cocktails or snacks. In this manner, this end of the kitchen becomes more than a dining area. The Smiths created an attractive morning room that is useful around the clock.

Contrast this to a kitchen in a mid-night mood was designed by Judith Ross and Nina Saunders of Brookline, Mass. Stainless steel, chrome, clear acrylic, ebony enamel, and gleaming crystal were their materials.

There are no windows. The suspended

glass chandelier, a tole lamp, and fluorescent fixtures recessed beneath the wall-hung cabinets provide plenty of light, regardless of the time of day. The stylized leaf and vine forms on the gray and white wallpaper and the dried flower arrangement on the stainless steel island offer only a suggestion of the world outside.

CLEAR ACRYLIC and chrome counter seats with glossy wet-look Naugahyde cushions carry out the after hours theme.

He eloquently talks of space, line, and form; of orchestrating aesthetic dialogues. Anything but pedestrian.

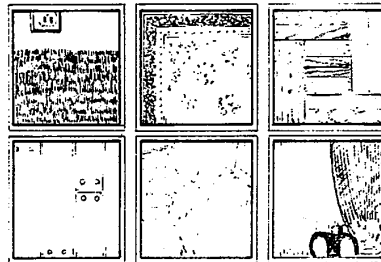

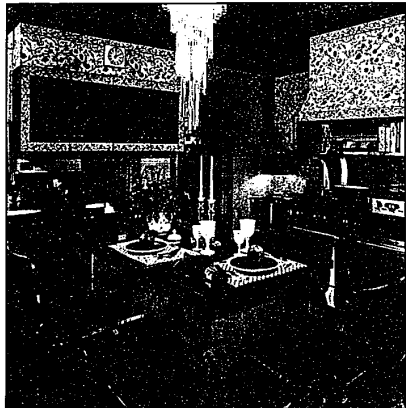

### Update 1979 —

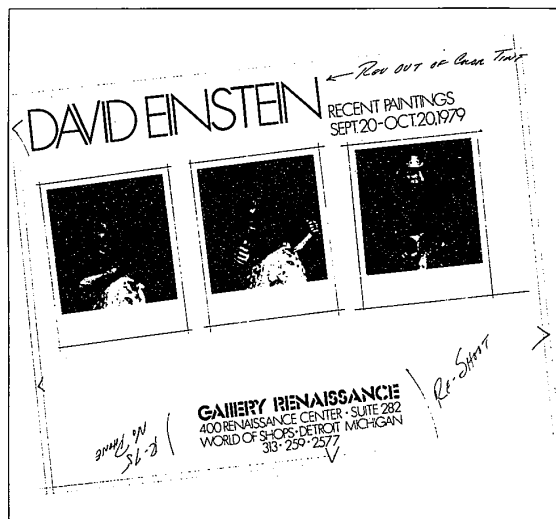

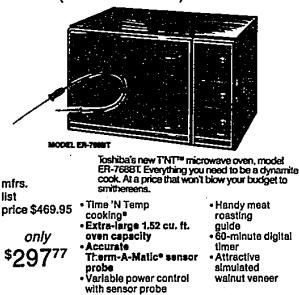
### Circa 1910 —

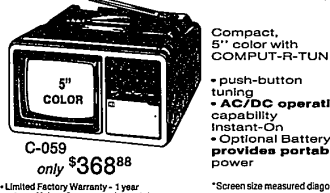
