The City of Farmington Hills Planning Commission will give formal consideration to a Proposed Amendment to the Text of the City of Farmington Hills Zoning Ordinance, which Amendatory Ordinance would in part read as follows:

Article DX-GS1 and Oxl A Office-Service Districts, Section 901. Principal Uses Permitted: Is hereby samended in part to read as follows:
Section 901. Principal Uses Permitted:
In a OS1 and OS1-A Office-Service District, no building or land shall be used and no building shall be erected except for one or more of the following specified uses unless otherwise provided in this Ordinance:

1. Office buildings for any of the following occupations; executive, administrative, professional, accounting, writing, clerical, stenographic, drafting and sales.

Medical offices, including clinics; hospitals.

Sanilariums or convalescent homes, in the OS-1 District only.

Banls, crufit unious, savings and loan associations, and similar uses; drivein facilities as an accessory use only.

Off-street parking lois.

Churches, in the OS-1 District only.

Other uses similar to the above uses.

Accessory structures and uses customarily incident to the above permitted
uses.
