The four pieces for fall are soft, washable suede. It's hard to believe the saddle stitched, impeccably tailored suedes are washable, but they are.


The speciality treated hides come from New Zealand and while the recommended cleaning procedure is to hand wash, absort moisture in a towel and lay flat to dry, Ms. Appel washes her own suedes on the gentle cycle of the washing machine. She then removes moisture in the air-only cycle on her dryer and lays flat to thoroughly dry.

Any wrinkling that occurs in the suede pieces is easily removed by using a dry warm iron over brown paper placed on top of the suede pieces, she explained.

"My real leather clothes are less on."
