last Sunday at Cherry Hill Lanes. She conquered Alea Rzaepke in the final, 237-137, and Alea's low score came when she encountered six splits.

IN THE MERRI-BOWL doubles, Ann Andrews showed the way with a 625. Ann Bogenschutz was forced to take second place with 596 even though she finished with a 241. Rose Appleman landed in third place with 571.

Meanwhile in the Aldergate league Pam Roman had a 244 in 507.

BETTY MARKWARDT took top honors in the Livonia Ladies Classic when she won the third game with 213-44 — 257 and the series with 527-132 — 651. In the other games Theresa Derrus won the first with 200-27 — 227 and Madeline Don 11-ine took the second with 185-37 — 222.
