Wine Press

Until recently the most dependable for me has been the double-whirly-bird, the item with the elongated verticle handle, a helix and two wooden blades or turners on top. One handle forces the helix into the cork, the second counter-turns it out via leverage.

While often doing great damage to the cork this tool usually works well and I wouldn't want to

ABOUT FIVE YEARS ago a new device came into the scene, the only one that does not pene-trate the body of the cork. Very simple in con-cept, it consists of an open handle and two exopen handle and two ex-actly opposite blades ex-tending down. The two blades slip via a twisting hand motion between the cork and the neck bottle. Once fully inserted, a sharp turning twist brings out the undam-aged cork.

This tool, the Ah-So, works better than any I know on weakened corks.
